



Becoming a new 4-H volunteer leader?

Complete the 4-H LEADER ORIENTATION by going on-line.

The procedure to complete new leader orientation and certification On-line is as easy as A - B - C

A: Start with paper forms from your local 4-H Club Leader:

- 1) Complete and submit your Volunteer Leader Application (yellow cover page) to your local 4-H Club Leader.
- 2.) Hold on to the copy of your Volunteer Self-Disclosure Form (green) to submit directly to the 4-H office with certificates from step B.

**B: Then go On-Line to merced4h.ucdavis.edu to complete the orientation:
Click on: Process to Become a 4-H Volunteer.**

- 3.) Watch the *4-H Orientation* video found here:

- 4.) Then complete the orientation quiz, <http://ucanr.org/orientation>
Print out quiz and turn into office.
- 5.) Watch the *Creating Safe Spaces* video and complete the quizzes, here:

Print out certificate and turn into office.

C: When the 4-H office gets the above reports a live scan application will be sent to the applicant to complete for fingerprinting.

- 6.) Complete a DOJ background check using Live Scan services
